There will be displays in church - All Welcome

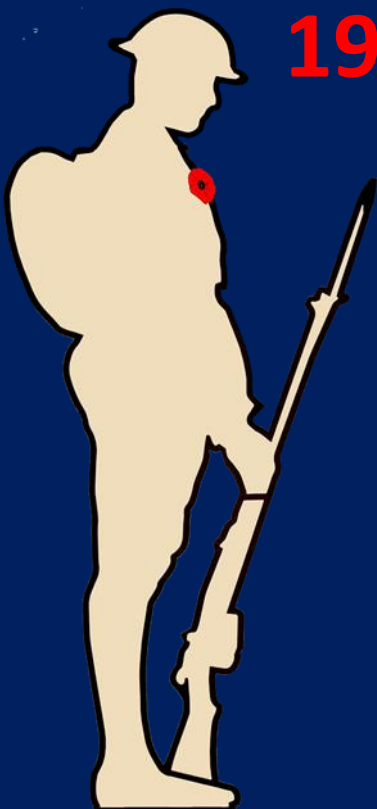
